

## IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER

### Availability of Monitoring Data for Unregulated Contaminants for Acton Water District

As required by the United States Environmental Protection Agency (US EPA), our water system has sampled for a series of unregulated contaminants. Unregulated contaminants are those that don't yet have a drinking water standard set by US EPA. The purpose of monitoring for these contaminants is to help US EPA decide whether the contaminants should have a public health protection standard.

#### ***What should I do?***

You do not have to do anything but as our customers you have a right to know that these data are available.

You may share this information with all the other people who drink this water, especially those who may not have received this notice directly (for example, people in apartments, nursing homes, schools, food establishments, medical facilities, and businesses). You can do this by posting this notice in a public place or distributing copies by hand or mail.
